Minutes of Committee Meeting held on 8 August 2007

1 Matters Arising

Action

- 1.1 **(2.1)** Hockley Hawkwell Ashingdon Parish Project for the Youth (HHAPPY).
The chairman updated the meeting on current initiatives, including good work being undertaken by Hawkwell Parish Council which has 3 objectives:
- short term – a teen shelter
 - medium term – a temporary youth club
 - long term – a permanent youth club.
- Activities are being co-ordinated across the 3 parishes although, disappointingly, Hockley PC are not enthusiastic.
It was also noted that the Parish Plan survey heavily supported, across all age groups, the need for improved youth facilities.
The meeting unanimously supported the initiative and suggested locations such as The Day Centre; the Parish Hall; land adjacent to church for appropriate facilities in Hockley.

2 New business:

2.1 The Rose Garden, Licensing Application

The Golf Driving Range have applied for a late night license to serve alcohol.
Members unanimously agreed that this is inappropriate in this site, which is close to housing and has a narrow access between houses. Agreed to object.
